2023-2025 TENTATIVE AGREEMENT PUBLIC HEARING

The Board of School Trustees of the Rensselaer Central Schools Corporation met for a Public Hearing on Friday, November 3, 2023 at the Rensselaer Central Schools Corporation Administrative Offices Board Conference Room. Board Members were present were Janice Deno, Cole Buschman, Gary Braasch and Emily Lyons. Courtney Wilcox, Rick Odle and Mark Jordan were absent.

President Braasch called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

President Braasch determined a quorum present.

President Braasch stated that there were no additions or deletions to the agenda. Ms. Lyons made a motion to approve the agenda. Mrs. Deno seconded the motion and the vote of the board was unanimous in favor of the motion.

President Braasch stated that the board would now open the floor for public comments on the terms of the 2023-2025 Tentative Agreement between the Rensselaer Central Schools Corporation and the Rensselaer Central Classroom Association pursuant to Indiana Code 20-29-6-1(a).

Stacy Kurdelak stated that on behalf of the Association she would like to thank the board and their team for working with us. A two year contract is just really nice. We thank you for listening to us and hearing our input on why these things are necessary.

Superintendent Craig stated that he would like to thank all the teachers for all the time that they put in. Just some highpoints, for health insurance, the agreement was to pay for an additional three and a half percent of the rate. Most of our teachers will see a decrease of what they pay for health insurance. Returning teachers will be seeing a \$3,000 increase in their base salary this year. The second year, there will be a stipend. He stated that he appreciated everybody's hard work in reaching an agreement.

President Braasch wished to echo those comments. He also thanked everyone for their hard work in reaching an agreement.

There were no other public comments.

Being there was nothing else to come before the board at this time, President Braasch adjourned the meeting 3:36 p.m. on a motion by Mr. Buschman and a second by Mrs. Deno.
